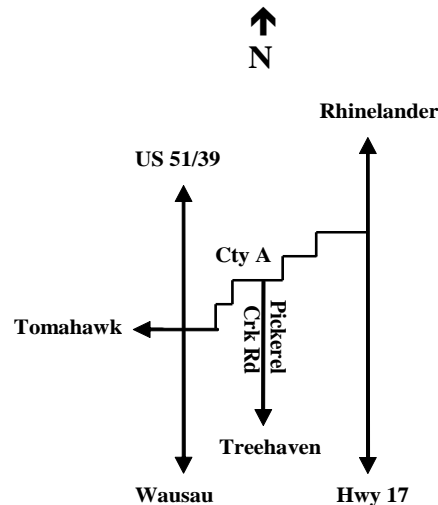

A new regional snowshoe race in Wisconsin, the “**Treehaven Tromp**”, is scheduled for February 11, 2012, at UWSP-Treehaven, an education and convention center of the University of Wisconsin Stevens Point. UWSP-Treehaven is located about nine miles east of Tomahawk.

The “*Tromp*”, a 5k and 10k snowshoe fun run and race, is part of the **Braveheart Snowshoe Racing Series** (www.cutemoose.net) and a 2011-2012 **United States Snowshoe Association** (USSSA) (www.snowshoeracing.com) Regional Qualifying Event Leading to the USSSA National Championships held in Frisco, Colorado on February 24-26. This is the last chance to qualify for Nationals.

Racers will find the course on our 1400 acres both beautiful and challenging, and our Northwoods retreat and education facility a perfect destination for a great snow shoe race. UWSP-Treehaven is a very central and easily accessed location in northern Wisconsin.

Optional: Friday night lodging

Those lodging at Treehaven on Friday evening may choose to participate in a night snowshoe hike followed by a campfire, guest speaker, and movie. A hearty breakfast is included prior to the 10:30 a.m. race on Saturday. After the race there will be an awards presentation followed by a chili luncheon.
